The project is effectively spread across three buildings of the St Bartholomew's Hospital estate which are all unused by the NHS Trust & have been vacant for several years.

The Old Pathology Building (Edwardian "Restrained Classical" Style Facade.)

The Modern Pathology Building (1960 Infill between Old Path adjacent to Grade 1 North Wing and Grade 2 Listed Museum)

The Residential Staff Quarters Building (Previously extended with retained Edwardian "Restrained Classical" Style Facade.)

The new design is being developed to meet Nuffield requirements to deliver efficient & patient focussed healthcare facilities and incorporating Nuffield experience & learning developed over 40 years operating similar Hospital sites.

The Nuffield site will be designed to operate as a stand-alone private hospital facility as far as possible but will share some services & suppliers with the existing hospital complex.

SEC Work Package

SEC's works comprise of manufacture, supply, and the installation of:

Window boards and reveal surrounds, skirting boards, glazed screens, pre-hung door sets, bespoke Joinery including design to wardrobes, reception desks, counters, nurse bases, beverage points and feature timber panelling to reception and lobby areas. Fix only group 2 FF&E.
